Summary (Introduction)

- ▶ Introduction save time so we do not need to read a whole paper -> present general idea
- ▶ Do not generalize finding in case study to global context
- ▶ Do not put literature review in introduction
- ▶ There is no specific order on how to write paper

Summary (Conclusion)

- ▶ Conclusion -> connects all part of the paper
- ▶ Conclusion show limitation of paper
- ▶ Do not cite anything conclusion
